

## Drug task force arrests Ashley man on drug, weapon charges

MARION — An Ashley man was arrested early Friday morning after being found in possession of drugs, cash and a concealed weapon.

Landon Jones, 26, 4 Vine St., Ashley, was stopped by detectives from the MARMET/METRICH Drug Task Force at 12:08 a.m. after jaywalking in the 200 block of Leader Street, according to a press release from Lt. Daryl Burbaugh.

Jones, who was with a juvenile, was stopped and found with approximately a half gram of crack cocaine, \$100 in cash and a concealed handgun. He was arrested on felony charges of possession of drugs and carrying a concealed weapon.

The juvenile was released to a family member.

The case will be forwarded to the Marion County Prosecutors Office to consider filing formal charges.
