

MARMET raid leads to arrests, drug seizure

MARION — A search warrant served Thursday evening led to the seizure of drugs and cash, as well as the arrests of three people.

Detectives with the MARMET/METRICH Drug Task Force recovered 24 grams of crack cocaine, 17 grams of marijuana and over \$1,100 in cash after serving a search warrant at 355 Girard Ave., according to a press release from Lt. Daryl Burbaugh.

The search warrant, served at 7:30 p.m. Thursday, was the result of citizen complaints and confidential informants.

William Burgess, 56, 355 Girard Ave., was arrested on felony charges of drug possession and permitting drug abuse; Charlotte Washington, 26, of Detroit, Mich., was arrested on charges of trafficking in drugs and possession of drugs; and Kristen Mustard, 26, 529 Davids St., was arrested on a felony charge of possession of drugs.

The case will be forwarded to the Marion County Prosecutor's Office for consideration of filing formal charges.
