

Marion man arrested on probation violation

MARION - A Marion man was arrested on a probation violation when a search warrant served at his home Wednesday afternoon led to the seizure of drugs and paraphernalia.

Officers with the Marion County Adult Probation Department assisted with the arrest of 21-year-old Kyle E. Landrum.

Lt. Daryl Burbaugh with the MARMET/METRICH Drug Task Force said officials are investigating the possibility of additional charges.

At around 2:30 p.m. Wednesday, detectives with the MARMET/METRICH Drug Task Force and Marion County Sheriff's Office Strike Team executed a search warrant at 713 Trinidad Drive.

Officers recovered prescription drugs, specifically a generic version of Ritalin, as well as drug paraphernalia including scales and pipes, Burbaugh said. The exact amount recovered was not immediately available.

The search warrant was the result of complaints from the neighborhood as well as additional evidence collected through surveillance.
