

## Marion officers seize crack, cash in search

MARION — Two women allegedly involved in illegal drug activity are in custody following a warrant execution.

On Monday, the MARMET/METRICH Drug Task Force executed a search warrant for a residence located in the 100 block of East Washington Street, just south of the downtown Marion area, states Lt. Daryl Burbaugh, Unit Supervisor, in press release.

Targets of the ensuing charges are:

- Bobbie L. Nibert, age 39, 2572 Dry Lane Road, LaRue, arrested for drug trafficking.
- LaShawn J. Mosley, age 24, 126 1/2 E. Washington St., arrested for drug trafficking, possession of drugs and tampering with evidence.

Seized from this location were 19 grams crack cocaine and over \$600 cash. The warrant is the result of confidential informants and surveillance by detectives of MARMET, joint task force made up of Marion City Police Officers and Marion County Deputy Sheriffs,

The felony arrest information will be presented to the Marion County Prosecutor's office for the filing of formal charges.
